

### Recreation Summit Lanark, Leeds and Grenville

The CDSBEO serves 8 counties in the region including Lanark, Leeds, Grenville, Stormont, Dundas, Glengarry, Prescott and Russell Counties. The Board's jurisdiction covers an area of 12,165 square kilometres.







The CDSBEO Catholic school community includes 40 elementary schools and 10 secondary schools including adult or alternative education programs.







User groups that have engaged in physical, social, spiritual and recreational activities include the following:

- Sports teams and clubs
- Air Cadets
- Adult groups (Volleyball, Basketball, Floor Hockey, Badminton, Yoga, Fitness Class etc.)
- Brownies, Beavers, Scouts and Girl Guides.



The 2009-2010 Community Use of Schools Report identified that:

- 253 permits were issued.
- 16,693 participants were engaged in physical, recreational, spiritual or social activities.
- 14,059 hours were reported for the 2009-2010 academic school year.



- The CDSBEO encourages non profit community groups to use Bishop Macdonell in Cornwall at no cost.
- Under special funding (Priority Schools Initiative), the Board receives funding to eliminate the normal use of schools fees for not-for-profit groups during non-school hours and weekends.
- Under the PSI, the Board has partnered with The Ottawa Basketball School to run four sessions on Saturdays, encompassing four different age groups, beginning November 12, 2011.





- CDSBEO hosted Velo Quebec and 2000 cyclists at St. John Catholic High School in Perth, Ontario.
- From August 5, 2011 to August 7, 2011, Vélo Québec used St. John to facilitate a cycling event that covered a distance from Brockville to Belleville with Perth being the second stop.
