Supports for Children in Need of Assistance to Access Sports / Recreation

The Good Samaritan Trust Fund

"The Good Samaritan Trust Fund was established in an effort to support those in our Catholic schools whose learning would be enhanced by the benefits it would provide, and in keeping with the mission of Jesus Christ, whose primary concern was for the poor and marginalized.

This fund targets the needs of students whose issues are not addressed by existing charity organizations."

Training / Supports for Teachers

- PD funding for teachers wishing to take Physical Education AQ courses, OPHEA courses, or attend Health and Physical Education conferences.
- Funds were made available to offset the cost of any such program up to \$200.00
- This funding was available to twenty teachers on a first-to-request basis.



Itinerant Teacher for DPA

- The Board created a position (Itinerant Teacher for DPA) and hired (reassigned) an experienced physical education teacher who went to every elementary school in the board for two or three consecutive days.
- During this time, she visited every class and modelled the use of the resource kit / cart to "build critical mass"



Partnership with KidActive

- KidActive personnel came to each elementary school to facilitate a half day workshop in a Grade 4 classroom.
- Game tags were provided to each school
- Workshop connected the concepts of healthy bodies, healthy communities, and a healthy environment
