- **Engaging multiple networks, community leaders/members & decision-makers.**

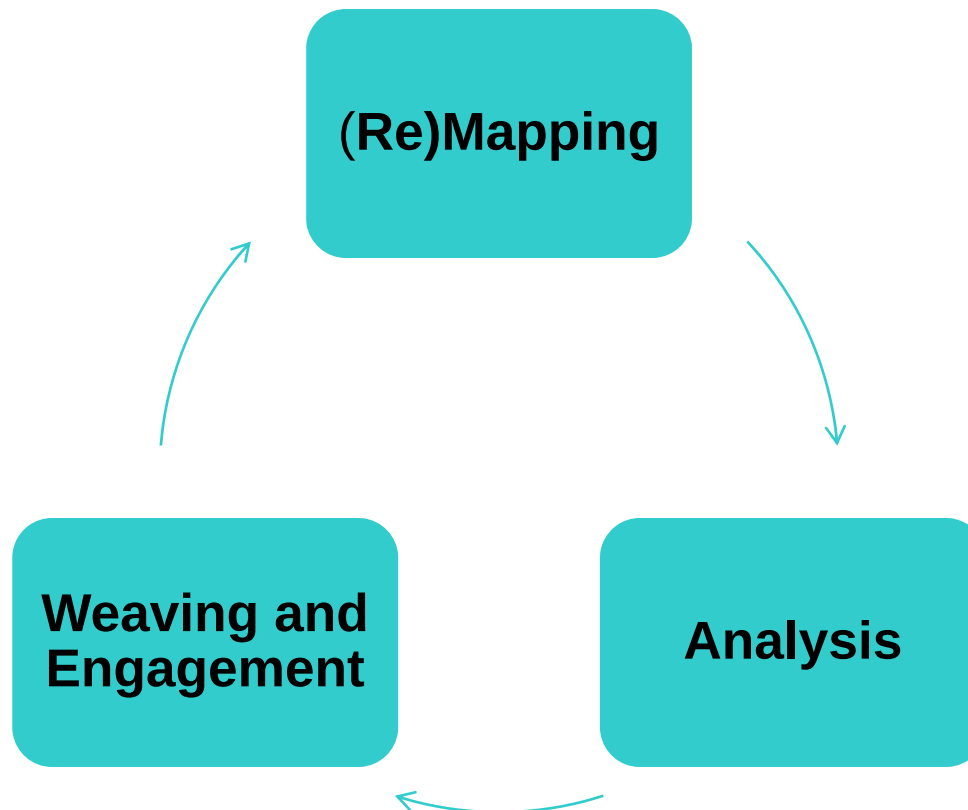


Underlying concepts

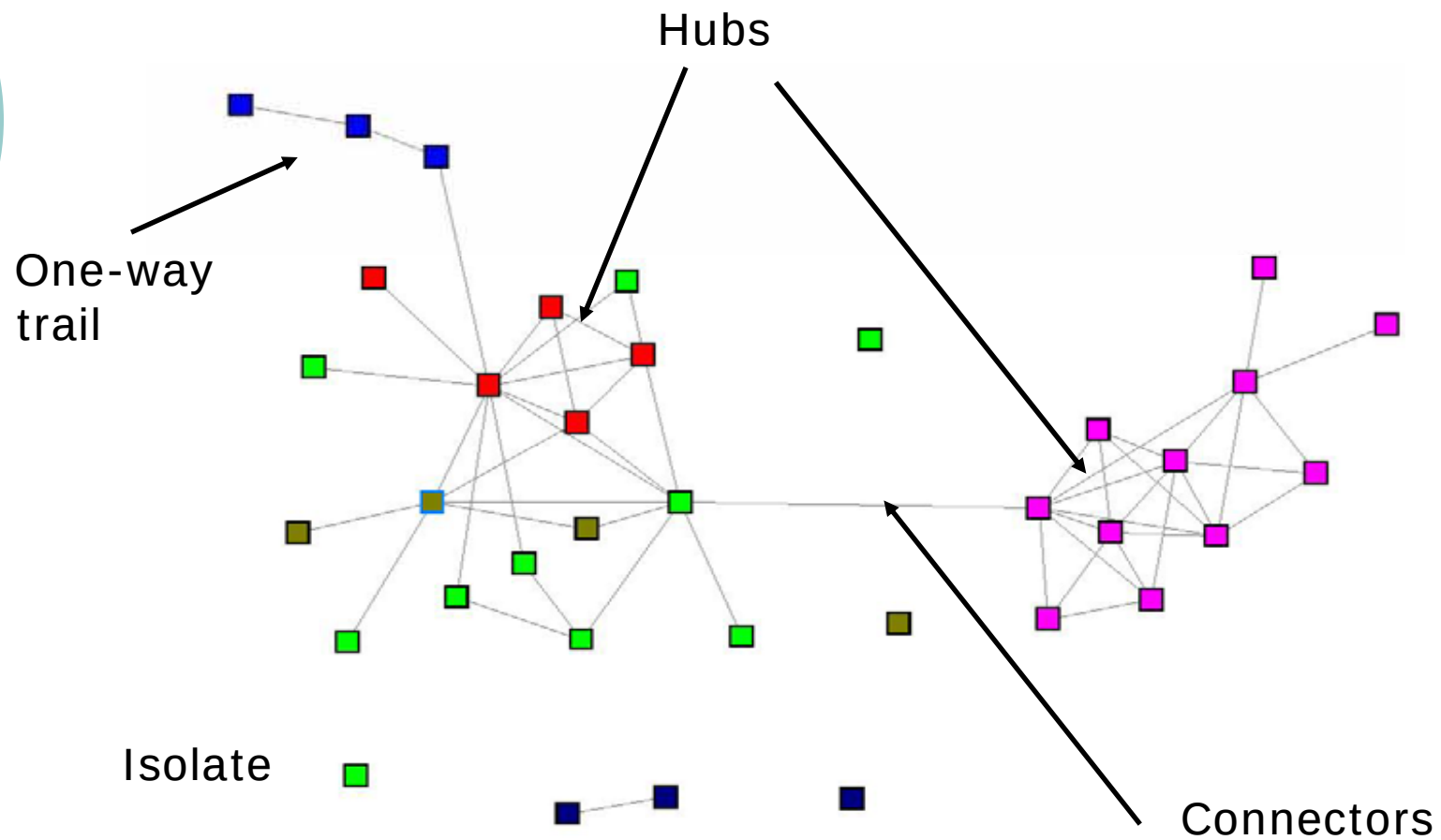


Network Mapping Process

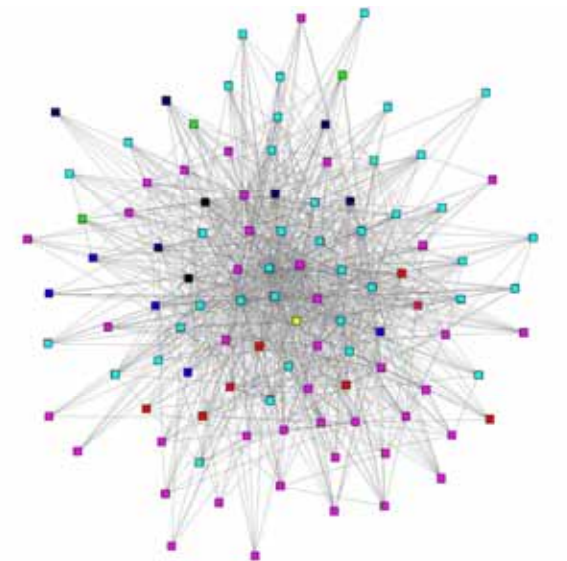
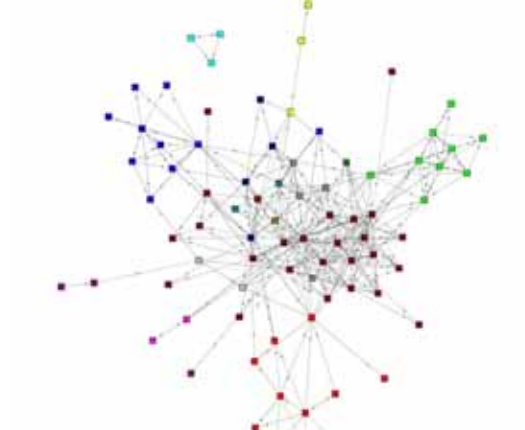
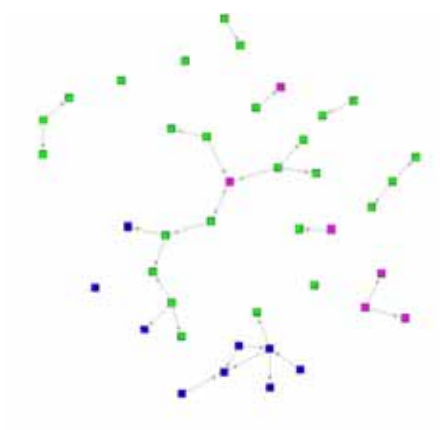
Start with commitment & interest in learning & improving, then:

What can be learned

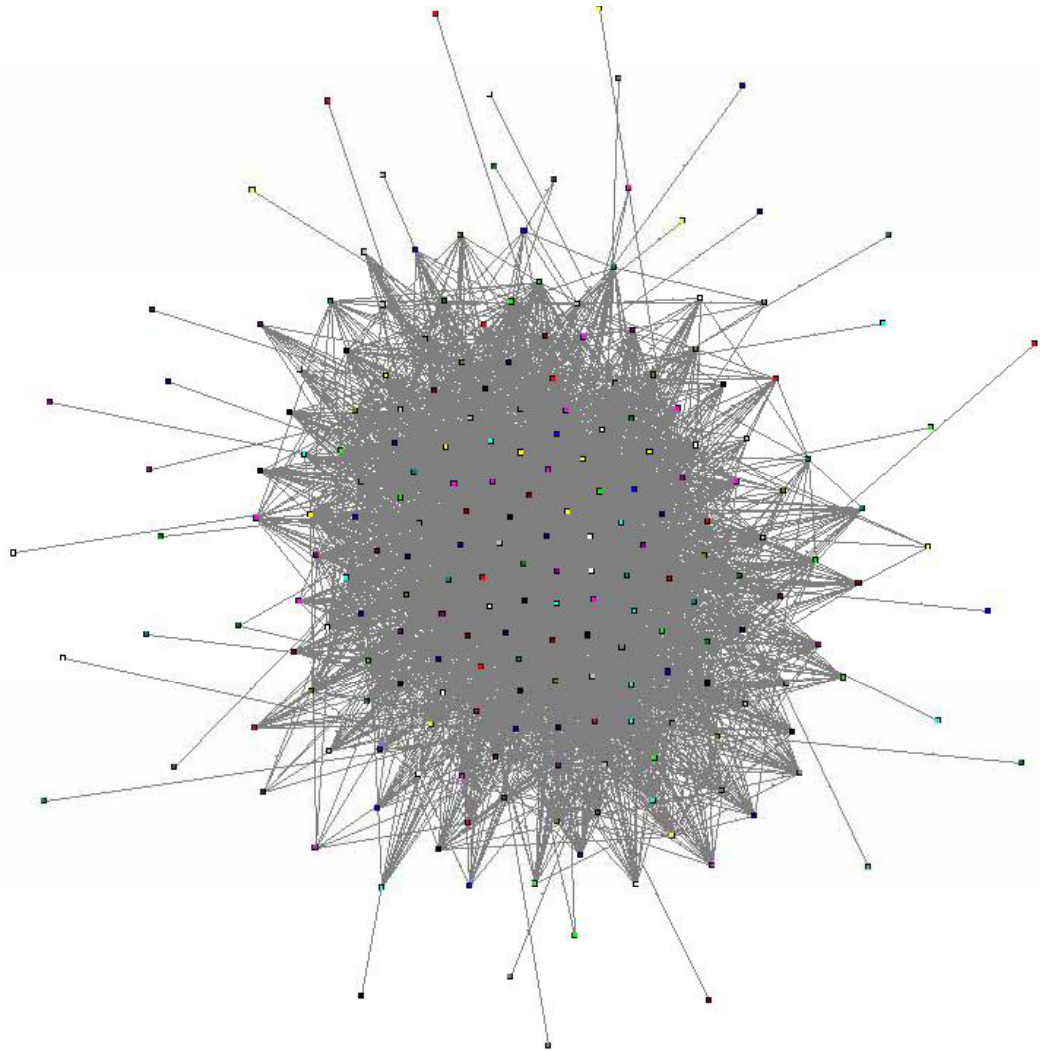
- **Various styles / types of leadership**

Your survey

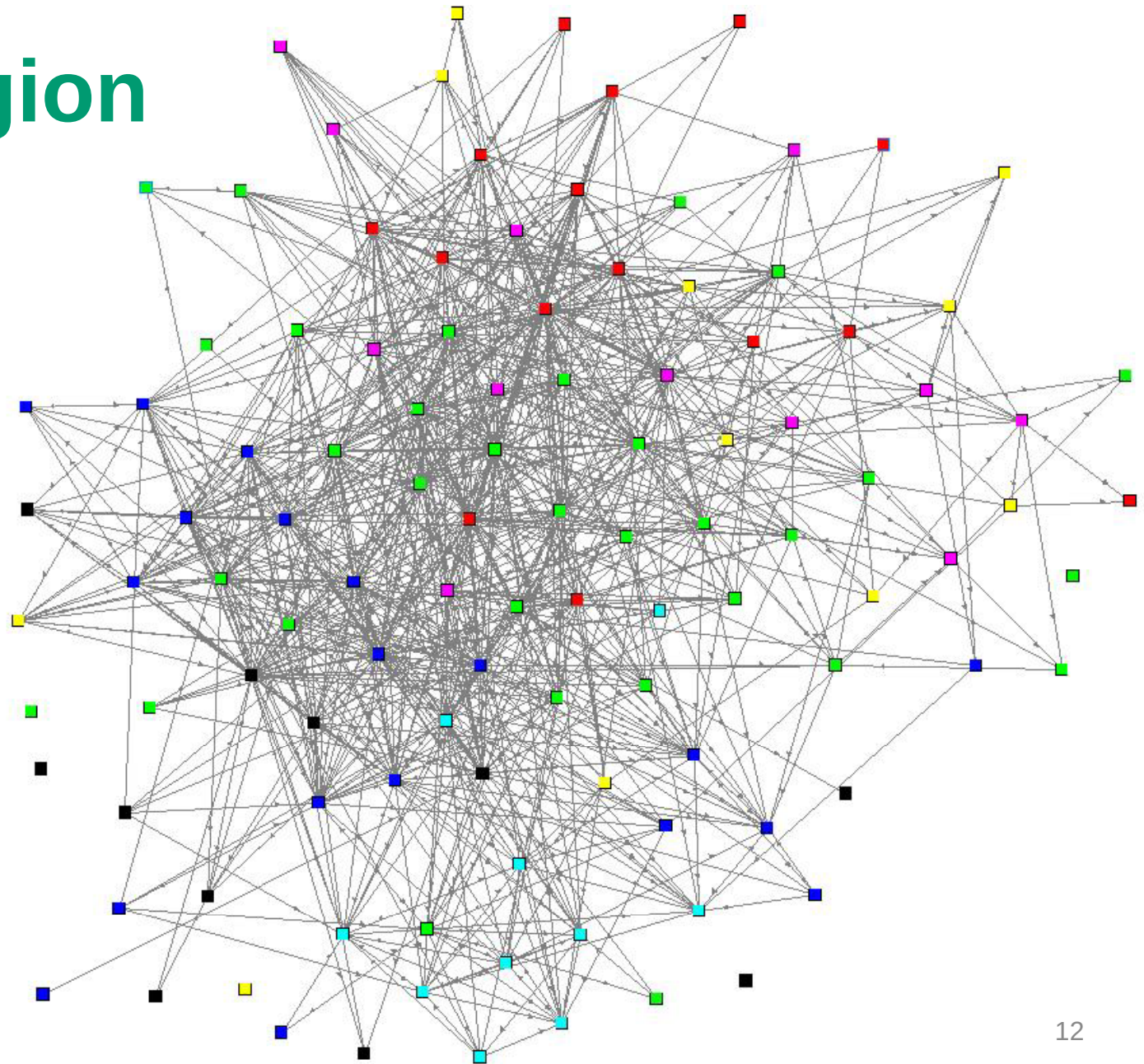
- **179 names**
